



Kills lice and nits (lice eggs) in only one application

What is LICENER?

LICENER is a shampoo for treating head lice that quickly and reliably kills lice and nits (lice eggs) with only one application. The efficacy of LICENER has been demonstrated in clinical studies on children with head lice. The shampoo is free from strong-smelling chemical ingredients and leaves the skin and hair feeling soft and silky without irritating the scalp. The active ingredient in LICENER is the naturally-acting extract from the neem tree. LICENER is easy to use and acts quickly and reliably in only 10 minutes.

Contents:

- One 100-ml bottle of LICENER shampoo containing the following ingredients: neem extract, aqua, polyglyceryl-3-caprate, cocamidopropyl betaine, glyceryl laurate, glycerol, lauryl glucoside, dicaprylyl ether, lauryl alcohol, benzyl alcohol, benzoic acid, sorbic acid, dimethyl glutarate and dimethyl adipate.

How does LICENER work?

The shampoo contains the naturally-acting neem extract, which forms a film over the lice in all stages of their development. This blocks the respiratory system of the lice and oxygen transport is disrupted. This causes the lice to suffocate within just a few minutes. The extract also penetrates the protective barrier of the nits. In this manner, LICENER kills lice as well as nits in only one application.

What are head lice?

Head lice are blood-sucking insects without wings. They are parasites that feed on human blood. Head lice and nits prefer warm and dark areas on the scalp. Therefore, they are often found behind the ears, along the hairline and the nape of the neck. The colour of the lice can vary from sand-coloured to almost black. After they have fed on blood, they turn dark red. The life-cycle of a head louse comprises three stages: nit, nymph and adult louse. The female louse attaches her eggs to the hairline using a sort of adhesive. The nits remain tightly anchored to the hair, which is why the distance to the scalp increases with further hair growth. After around 7 – 10 days, the nymphs hatch from the nits and, after a further 7 days, develop into fully-grown lice. An adult female louse can then lay up to 8 eggs per day.

How to use LICENER

STEP 1: Apply LICENER shampoo to dry hair. Make sure that you use a sufficient amount of the shampoo to cover the hair completely. We recommend using one bottle of LICENER per person (depending on hair length). Thoroughly massage the LICENER shampoo from the scalp to the tips of the hair and then allow it to act for 10 minutes. If several family members are infected with head lice, all members should be treated with LICENER on the same day in order to prevent a reinfection.

STEP 2: Rinse away the LICENER shampoo thoroughly using lukewarm water. You should avoid getting the shampoo in your eyes, because, as with any shampoo, this can cause eye irritation. It is not necessary to wash your hair with a normal shampoo following treatment with LICENER. If necessary, you can comb your dried hair using a special nit comb following treatment with LICENER, in order to remove the dead lice and nits.

The application of LICENER can be repeated at any time without any problems, should reinfestation occur through head lice from other infected persons.

Important

- LICENER is suitable for adults and children from 2 years of age onwards. No studies have been conducted on the use of LI-CENER in children under the age of 2 years.
- LICENER should not be used in people who are allergic to any of the ingredients of LICENER.
- Like any shampoo, LICENER can cause mild eye irritation. Therefore, avoid contact with the eyes. In case of eye contact, rinse thoroughly with water.
- In case of hypersensitivity or allergic reactions or other side effects, discontinue use and seek advice from your doctor.
- If you intend to use this product during pregnancy or when breast-feeding, we recommend consulting your doctor or pharmacist beforehand.
- Store at 5 25°C and out of the reach of children.
- If you use LICENER in an acrylic sink or bath, please wash off any spilt shampoo immediately using water, so that no staining can occur.
- For external use only.
- Do not use after the expiry date (see label on back of bottle).
